

Op zondag 13 november zal in Paradiso aan de Weteringschans een middag worden georganiseerd waarbij de beroemde en beruchte Chaos Computer Club centraal zal staan. Naast een demonstratie van een drietal CCC-leden en een discussie over dit Hamburgs collectief, wordt die dag tevens de Nederlandse vertaling van Das Chaos Computer Buch gepresenteerd.

De Chaos Computer Club uit Hamburg heeft in de afgelopen jaren een aardige reputatie weten op te bouwen bij de liefhebbers én de slachtoffers van het verschijnsel computerkraken. Ondanks het feit dat de CCC veel meer doet dan het inbreken in grote systemen alleen, heeft zij toch de naam van een soort moderne Robin Hood in computerland gekregen. De spectaculaire inbraak in het computersysteem van het NASA-hoofdkwartier in 1987 zal daar ongetwijfeld bij geholpen hebben.

De doelstellingen en ideologieën van de CCC krijgen vaak door de opwinding rond het nieuws van deze inbraken niet de juiste aandacht. Om nu wat meer licht in de 'duistere' praktijken van de CCC te brengen, zullen op 13 november Steffen Wernery, Wau Holland, Bernd Fix en Jürgen Wieckmann in Paradiso aanwezig zijn. Zij verzorgen die dag een uitgebreide, deels audiovisuele presentatie van enkele inbraken uit het verleden en geven hierbij de achterliggende informatie over het hoe en waarom. Daarbij zal zeker ook duidelijk worden dat de CCC niet alleen uit sensatie-beluste kwajongens bestaat.

Na deze show staat de presentatie van het Chaos Computer Boek op het programma. Het boek dat in de Duitse uitgave al flink verkocht, behandelt naast enkele kraakavonturen tevens onderwerpen als kunstmatige intelligentie, privacy, virussen, en de Kunst van het programmeren. De Nederlandse primeur zal ter plekke worden verkocht.

Na deze presentatie volgt er een debat en vervolgens een openbare discussie, waarbij de 'voors en tegens' met betrekking tot de CCC centraal zullen staan. Het debat wordt geleid door Marieke Nelissen. Zij geeft computercursussen bij de gemeente Amsterdam. In het pannel zijn onder andere de professoren Herschberg en Franken en een vertegenwoordiging van de Stichting Kwaad Leven aanwezig. De middag zal worden afgesloten met de mogelijkheid tot napraten en het stellen van technische vragen aan de medewerkers van de Chaos Computer Club.

- 12.00 uur: een show van de Chaos Computer Club door Wernery, Holland, Fix en Wieckmann
- 13.30 uur: presentatie van het Chaos Computer Boek
- 14.00 uur: debat met aansluitend een openbare discussie
- 15.30 uur: napraten en de mogelijkheid tot het stellen van technische vragen aan de CCC
